(A) Devilbiss Hall Replacement Facility. Prepare detailed plans to construct a new science building to replace Devilbiss Hall, provided that the scope of the project may not exceed 145,500 gross square feet, which represents the project's dimensions incorporated in the program plan approved in January 1997. [It is the intent of the General Assembly that the overall cost of the project to the State not exceed \$33,213,000] 1,395,000

RM00 MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY
(Baltimore City)

(A) New Fine Arts Center. Construct a new Fine Arts Center on the Montebello campus, provided that the scope of the project may not exceed 115,000 gross square feet, which represents the amount contained in the program plan approved in March 1995. [It is the intent of the General Assembly that the total State cost not exceed \$33 million which is the estimated cost based on the approved program] 27,302,000

(C) Lillie Carroll Jackson Museum. Provide a grant to Morgan State University for the repair and renovation of the building located at 1320 Eutaw Place in Baltimore City that holds the Lillie Carroll Jackson Museum, provided that no funds may be expended until equal and matching [federal] NON-STATE funds are received. THIS AUTHORIZATION MAY NOT TERMINATE BEFORE JUNE 1, 2001 300,000

Chapter 138 of the Acts of 1998

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 1998 in the total principal amount of [\$405,716,000] \$404,963,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with Sections 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, Section 22 of the Code.
