

(3) REVIEW AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO ALIGN STATE STATUTES, REGULATIONS, PROGRAMS, SERVICES, AND BUDGETARY PRIORITIES WITH THE STATE POLICIES AND ACTIONS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION;

(4) SEARCH FOR ANY INTERDEPARTMENTAL GAPS, INCONSISTENCIES, AND INEFFICIENCIES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OR ATTAINMENT OF THE STATE POLICIES AND ACTIONS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION;

(5) IDENTIFY ANY NEW LAWS, REGULATIONS, PROGRAMS, SERVICES, AND BUDGETARY PRIORITIES THAT ARE NEEDED TO ENSURE AND PROMOTE DESIRED CONDITIONS OF WELL-BEING FOR MARYLAND CHILDREN ~~AND YOUTH,~~ YOUTH, AND FAMILIES;

(6) SERVE AS AN INFORMATIONAL RESOURCE FOR THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE ON LEGISLATIVE POLICY MATTERS CONCERNING CHILDREN ~~AND YOUTH,~~ YOUTH, AND FAMILIES; AND

(7) PERFORM OTHER ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING IMPROVING PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE SPECIAL NEEDS OF MARYLAND CHILDREN ~~AND YOUTH,~~ YOUTH, AND FAMILIES.

(L) (1) SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THIS TITLE, THE COMMITTEE SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR.

(2) THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE:

- (I) A DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK OF THE COMMITTEE; AND
- (II) ANY RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October 1, 1999~~ June 1, 1999. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of May 31, 2002, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
