(H) "TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE" INCLUDES ASSISTANCE IN THE IDENTIFICATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF EFFECTIVE PRACTICES FOR AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS.

(A) THERE IS A MARYLAND AFTER-SCHOOL OPPORTUNITY FUND PROGRAM.

(B) THERE IS A MARYLAND AFTER-SCHOOL OPPORTUNITY FUND IN THE PROGRAM.

(C) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ADVISORY BOARD, SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.

(D) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL CONSULT WITH THE MARYLAND PARTNERSHIP FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES IN DEVELOPING THE PROGRAM'S STANDARDS AND IN OPERATING THE PROGRAM.

(A) THERE IS AN ADVISORY BOARD ON AFTER-SCHOOL OPPORTUNITY PROGRAMS IN THE PROGRAM.

(B) THE ADVISORY BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS:

(1) THE GOVERNOR OR THE GOVERNOR'S DESIGNEE;
