## CHAPTER 16

(House Bill 2)

AN ACT concerning

## Children's Maryland Health Program Programs Expansion Act of 2000

FOR the purpose of expanding eligibility for the Children and Families Health Care Program to certain individuals under a private option plan; requiring that certain individuals enrolled in the Program receive health benefits through an employer-sponsored health benefit plan or a certain managed care organization: establishing certain criteria for approval of a certain employer-sponsored health benefit plan; providing that certain individuals enrolled in the Program receive health benefits through certain managed care organizations; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to perform certain administrative duties; requiring certain parents and guardians to pay a certain family contribution; changing the name of the Children and Families Health Care Program; providing that certain individuals are exempt from certain enrollment restrictions; authorizing the Department to disapprove a certain application if the applicant was covered by certain insurance that was voluntarily terminated within a certain time frame; specifying that certain benefits offered under a certain employer-sponsored health benefit plan are subject to certain requirements; specifying that certain carriers that offer certain benefits are required to offer the benefits only to certain employers; altering the income threshold for pregnant women to receive certain benefits under the Medical Assistance Program; requiring the Department to submit a certain report to the Governor and General Assembly on or before a certain date; making certain stylistic and technical changes; providing for the effective dates of this Act; defining certain terms; providing for a e delayed effective date dates for portions of this Act; and generally relating to health insurance coverage for children.
