**Chapter 4 of the Acts of the First Special Session of 1992, as amended by Chapter 125 of the Acts of 1996 and Chapter 212 of the Acts of 1999**

Section 1

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 1992 in the total principal amount of [\$346,410,681] \$346,260,681. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with Section 8-117 through Section 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, Section 22 of the Code.
