- (1) TO PILOT A VESSEL WHEN THE VESSEL-IS UNDERWAY WITH TUG ASSISTANCE IN ANY OF THE PORTS OF MARYLAND;
- (2) (1) TO MANEUVER A VESSEL DURING BERTHING OR UNBERTHING OPERATIONS WITH TUG ASSISTANCE; OR
- (3) (2) WHILE ABOARD THE VESSEL, TO SHIFT A VESSEL WITHIN A PORT, WITH TUG ASSISTANCE.

ANY VESSEL USING TUG ASSISTANCE IN THE PORTS OF MARYLAND, RECARDLESS OF THE WEIGHT OF THE VESSEL OR WHETHER THE VESSEL IS DRIVEN BY MOTOR, STEAM, OR SAIL, SHALL EMPLOY A DOCKING MASTER LICENSED UNDER THIS TITLE TO PROVIDE DOCKING SERVICES. - (A) (1) THE BOARD CONSISTS OF 7 5 MEMBERS.
 - (2) OF THE 7 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD:
 - (I) 2 SHALL BE LICENSED DOCKING MASTERS;
 - (II) 1 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE MARITIME INDUSTRY;
- (III) 1 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE STEAMSHIP INDUSTRY WHO ACTIVELY PROCURES THE SERVICES OF A LICENSED DOCKING MASTER;
- (IV) (II) 1 SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF A TOWING BOAT COMPANY SERVING THE PORT OF BALTIMORE; AND
 - (III) 2 SHALL BE CONSUMER MEMBERS.
- (3) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT EACH MEMBER WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY AND THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
