AN ACT concerning:

Landmarks Preservation Commission

FOR the purpose of placing certain limits on the construction, renovation, reconstruction, alteration, or demolition of a structure during a certain time period pending the creation of a historic district, or during a certain time period pending a decision of the Landmarks Preservation Commission with respect to a preliminary landmarks list; placing certain time limits on decisions of the Commission and the County Executive and the County Council; clarifying the authority of the County Council with regard to the final landmarks list; amending the Council's hearing and notice requirements; clarifying the method of adoption of Commission regulations; providing for compliance with correction notices; and generally relating to historic structures.
