

(3) IF THE DENTIST SIGNS A WRITTEN STATEMENT AGREEING TO DONATE AT LEAST 100 HOURS OF DENTAL SERVICES WITHOUT COMPENSATION IN A FACILITY THAT SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (D)(1) AND (2) OF THIS SECTION;

(4) IF THE DENTIST PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION AS REQUIRED BY THE BOARD WHICH EVIDENCES THAT THE LICENSEE IS COVERED BY MALPRACTICE INSURANCE; AND

(5) IF THE DENTIST DOES NOT OTHERWISE PRACTICE DENTISTRY FOR PROFIT.

(F) WHILE IT IS EFFECTIVE, A RETIRED VOLUNTEER DENTAL HYGIENIST'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE:

(1) ONLY IN A DENTAL OFFICE, DENTAL CLINIC, AMBULATORY CARE FACILITY, OR HOSPITAL;

(2) ONLY FOR AN ENTITY PROVIDING MEDICAL CARE TO THE POOR, ELDERLY, OR HANDICAPPED THAT IS OPERATED BY:

(I) THE STATE OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT;

(II) A BONA FIDE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION; OR

(III) ANY OTHER SETTING ENTITY AUTHORIZED UNDER REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD;

(3) IF THE DENTAL HYGIENIST SIGNS A WRITTEN STATEMENT AGREEING TO DONATE AT LEAST 100 HOURS OF DENTAL HYGIENE SERVICES WITHOUT COMPENSATION IN A FACILITY THAT SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (G)(1) AND (2) OF THIS SECTION;

(4) IF THE DENTAL HYGIENIST PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION AS REQUIRED BY THE BOARD WHICH EVIDENCES THAT THE LICENSEE IS COVERED BY MALPRACTICE INSURANCE; AND

(5) IF THE DENTAL HYGIENIST DOES NOT OTHERWISE PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE FOR PROFIT.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.
