SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

<u>Article 83B - Department of Housing and Community Development</u> 11-103.

- (c) (1) The Board of Trustees shall include one representative of each of the following:
 - (i) Title companies doing business in the State;
 - (ii) The Maryland Center for Community Development;
 - (iii) Financial institutions doing business in the State;
 - (iv) Local governments;
 - (v) Nonprofit housing developers;
 - (vi) For profit housing developers;
 - (vii) Public housing authorities; and
 - (viii) Social services providers.
- (2) The Board of Trustees shall include three representatives of the general public.
- (3) SERVICE AS A TRUSTEE MAY NOT BE DEEMED AN OFFICE OR EMPLOYMENT OF THE STATE FOR PURPOSES OF ANY STATUTORY PROHIBITION AGAINST HOLDING TWO PUBLIC POSITIONS.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That <u>Section 1 of</u> this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2000.

CHAPTER 133

(House Bill 518)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Veterans Commission - Membership

FOR the purpose of adding a representative from the Maryland Coalition of the Retired Enlisted Association to the Maryland Veterans Commission; and generally relating to the Maryland Veterans Commission.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
