Pursuant to the provisions of Article 33, Section 11-601, Annotated Code of Maryland, and the Code of Maryland Regulations, COMAR 33.08, I, Linda H. Lamone, Administrator of the State Board of Elections, hereby certify that at the November 7, 2000, General Election Chapter 119 of the Acts of the 1999 Maryland General Assembly was submitted to the voters of the State in accordance with the provisions of Article XIV of the Maryland Constitution as follows:

Question 1
Constitutional Amendment
Cecil County - Election and Terms of Office
for the Board of County Commissioners

Excepts the Board of County Commissioners of Cecil County from the constitutional requirements that all State and county elections be held only in every fourth year on a particular date and that all State and county officers hold four-year terms, in order to allow staggered terms with elections held every second year.

It is hereby certified that at the election Chapter 119 received 875,349 votes cast for the adoption and 402,432 votes cast against the adoption. Therefore, Chapter 119 has been approved by the voters.

Prince George's County - Property for Redevelopment Purposes

Expressly authorizes the Prince George's County Council to take property immediately upon a finding of immediate need for redevelopment purposes; designates properties eligible for taking as those located between Suitland Federal Center and Silver Hill Road that are also within any two certain designated areas (a revitalization tax
