It is hereby certified that at the election Chapter 111 received 10,645 votes cast for the adoption and 9,010 votes cast against the adoption. Therefore, Chapter 111 has been adopted by the voters.

**Alcoholic Beverages - Montgomery County (Kensington) -
Special B-K License MC 14-00**

To approve license classification B-K unique to Kensington that amends Maryland state law to allow restaurants in designated commercial corridors of the Town of Kensington to sell beer, wine, and liquor for on-site consumption only under highly restrictive circumstances, including a requirement that food sales constitute at least 70 percent of total restaurant revenues.

It is hereby certified that at the special election held June 5, 2000 in the Town of Kensington, Chapter 155 of the Acts of the General Assembly received 285 votes cast for the adoption and 127 votes cast against the adoption. Therefore, Chapter 155 has been adopted by the voters.
