

(3) (I) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL, THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY AN INSPECTOR AND A RECORDING SECRETARY WHO SHALL BE EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY AS PROVIDED IN THE COUNTY BUDGET.

(II) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL, THE BOARD MAY APPOINT LEGAL COUNSEL.

(III) RESTRICTIONS APPLICABLE TO BOARD MEMBERS SHALL APPLY TO LEGAL COUNSEL AND STAFF ASSIGNED TO THE BOARD.

(IV) COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES AND RULES SHALL APPLY TO:

- 1. STAFF ASSIGNED TO THE BOARD; AND
- 2. BOARD AND STAFF EXPENSES.

(V) BOARD AND STAFF EXPENSES SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR IN THE COUNTY BUDGET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2003.

CHAPTER 91
(House Bill 939)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County – Alcoholic Beverages – Board of License Commissioners

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Dorchester County to employ an inspector and a recording secretary with the approval of the County Council; requiring that the inspector and recording secretary be employees of the county as provided for in the county budget; authorizing the Board to appoint legal counsel with the approval of the County Council; specifying that certain restrictions apply to legal counsel and staff assigned to the Board; requiring that county personnel policies and rules apply to certain persons and expenses; making technical corrections; and generally relating to the Dorchester Board of License Commissioners.
