CHAPTER 283

(House Bill 191)

AN ACT concerning

Regulated Lobbyists - Registration Fee - Increase Lobbyist Registration Fund - Registration Fees and Reversion of Unused Funds

FOR the purpose of altering the registration fee for certain lobbyists required to register with the State Ethics Commission; requiring that any unused balance in the Lobbyist Registration Fund at the end of any fiscal year revert to the General Fund of the State; and generally relating to the Lobbyist Registration Fund.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

15-210.

- (a) (1) There is a Lobbyist Registration Fund.
 - (2) The Fund includes all fees collected under Subtitle 7 of this title.
- (b) (1) The Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund [that is not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article].
- (c) (1) The Treasurer shall separately hold, and the Comptroller shall account for, the Fund.
- (2) The Fund shall be invested and reinvested in the same manner as other State funds.
- (3) Expenditures from the Fund shall be made in accordance with an appropriation approved by the General Assembly in the annual budget.
- (d) The Fund shall be used to defray the expenses of administering Subtitle 7 of this title.
