

(ii) An institution of higher education that receives funds under this paragraph shall provide the Commission with an annual audit describing the disposition of the funds.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October~~ July 1, 2003.

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## CHAPTER 450

### (House Bill 778)

AN ACT concerning

#### **Education - Baltimore County - Public School Employees**

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "public school employee" as it applies to provisions that relate to organizations of employees in Baltimore County; establishing a certain unit of certain employees in Baltimore County; authorizing only a certain number of units in Baltimore County; providing that a certain unit shall be deemed the designated representative for a certain unit of employees; providing that this Act may not be construed to modify, amend, or supercede certain provisions of law; providing that this Act may not be construed to confer certain rights of certification on certain noncertified employees; and generally relating to organizations for public school employees in Baltimore County.
