~~FOR the purpose of altering a certain subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for military retirement income over a certain period of time; providing that retirement income that is included in a certain subtraction may not be taken into account for purposes of a certain subtraction modification allowed under the income tax for certain individuals who are at least a certain age or who are disabled or have disabled spouses; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a subtraction modification for military retirement income.~~

FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study the Financial Impact of Retired Military Service Personnel on the Economy of the State; providing for the composition of the Task Force; requiring the Governor to designate the chairman of the ~~task force~~ Task Force; providing for the staffing of the ~~task force~~ Task Force; prohibiting a member from receiving certain compensation; authorizing a member to receive certain reimbursement; establishing the duties of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to report its findings to the Governor and the General Assembly; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to a Task Force to Study the Financial Impact of Retired Military Service Personnel on the Economy of the State.
