

(B) THE COUNCIL SHALL BE INDEPENDENT AND LOCATED IN THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES FOR BUDGETARY AND ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES ONLY.

(C) STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE COUNCIL SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES.

42.

(A) THE COUNCIL SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING 25 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR:

(1) THE SPECIAL SECRETARY FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES OR THE SPECIAL SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(2) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS OR THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE;

(3) THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(4) THE SECRETARY OF JUVENILE JUSTICE OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(5) THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(6) THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(7) ONE MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND NOMINATED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

(8) ONE MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF MARYLAND NOMINATED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;

(9) ONE INDIVIDUAL WITH EXPERIENCE OR EXPERTISE WITH THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM;

(10) ONE LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER;

(11) ONE LOCAL SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS;

(12) THREE INDIVIDUALS FROM LOCAL JURISDICTIONS, INCLUDING AT LEAST ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A LOCAL MANAGEMENT BOARD;

(13) THREE INDIVIDUALS WHO REPRESENT COMMUNITY LEADERS FROM ORGANIZATIONS AND FAITH COMMUNITIES THAT HAVE EXPERIENCE OR EXPERTISE WITH THE SERVICES OFFERED IN SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS;

(14) THREE CONSUMERS OF SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CARE, INCLUDING STUDENTS AND THE STUDENTS' PARENTS;

(15) A PEDIATRICIAN;
