- (B) IN MAKING THE APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL ENSURE THAT THE COUNCIL IS REPRESENTATIVE OF:
 - (1) THE GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS OF THE STATE; AND
 - (2) MINORITY POPULATIONS OF THE STATE.
- (1) ONE PHYSICIAN MEMBER OF THE MEDICAL AND CHIRURGICAL FACULTY PUBLIC HEALTH COUNCIL:
- (2) ONE PHYSICIAN MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF PEDIATRICS WHO SPECIALIZES IN INFECTIOUS DISEASES:
- (3) ONE PHYSICIAN MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF PEDIATRICS WITH EXPERIENCE IN PRIVATE PRACTICE;
- (4) ONE PHYSICIAN MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND ACADEMY OF FAMILY PHYSICIANS:
- (5) ONE PHYSICIAN MEMBER OF THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS INTERNAL MEDICINE SOCIETY OF MARYLAND;
 - (6) FOUR PHYSICIANS WHO ADMINISTER VACCINES:
 - (7) ONE LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER:
- (8) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE DEPARTMENT'S CENTER FOR IMMUNIZATIONS:
- (9) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE DEPARTMENT'S VACCINES FOR CHILDREN PROGRAM, AND
- (10) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND SCHOOL SYSTEM, NOMINATED BY THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS.
- (C) THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYCIENE SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION, BASED ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE APPROPRIATE MEDICAL SOCIETY OF AGENCY.
- (D) THE PHYSICIAN MEMBER OF THE MEDICAL AND CHIRURGICAL FACULTY PUBLIC HEALTH COUNCIL SHALL:
 - (1) CHAIR THE COMMISSION:
- (2) ESTABLISH SUBCOMMITTEES TO FACILITATE THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION: AND
- (3) APPOINT SUBCOMMITTEE CHAIRS FROM AMONG THE COMMISSION MEMBERS.
- (E) (C) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS 4-3 YEARS.
