13-1104. GAMING PERMIT REVIEW BOARD.

(A) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A CHARLES COUNTY GAMING PERMIT REVIEW BOARD.

(B) MEMBERSHIP.

(1) THE BOARD CONSISTS OF SEVEN MEMBERS.

(2) OF THE SEVEN MEMBERS OF THE BOARD:

(I) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE;

(II) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE;

(III) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE CLERGY;

(IV) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF A FUNDRAISING ORGANIZATION IN THE COUNTY;

(V) ONE SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WITH BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE IN FINANCE; AND

(VI) TWO SHALL BE MEMBERS AT LARGE.

(3) EACH MEMBER AT LARGE:

(I) SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;

(II) MAY NOT BE A MEMBER OF A FUNDRAISING ORGANIZATION OR OTHERWISE BE SUBJECT TO REGULATION BY THE BOARD;

(III) MAY NOT, WITHIN 1 YEAR BEFORE APPOINTMENT, HAVE HAD A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN OR HAVE RECEIVED COMPENSATION FROM A PERSON REGULATED BY THE BOARD; AND
