- (a) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "VEHICLE" DOES NOT INCLUDE A WHEELCHAIR
- Except as provided in subsection (b) [or (c)], (C), OR (D) of this section, a person may not drive any vehicle on a sidewalk or sidewalk area unless it is a permanent or authorized temporary driveway.
- (b) (1) For purposes of this subsection, "bicycle" does not include "moped", as defined in § 11–134.1 of this article.
- (2) Where permitted by local ordinance, a person may ride a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle on a sidewalk or sidewalk area.
- **f**(c) Where permitted UNLESS PROHIBITED by local ordinance, an individual with a disability may use a special vehicle OTHER THAN A WHEELCHAIR on sidewalks or sidewalk areas from one half hour after sunrise to one half hour before sunset.
- (D) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY USE A WHEELCHAIR ON SIDEWALKS OR SIDEWALK AREAS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 21–501.1 OF THIS TITLE.
