(b) If the Commissioner determines that a nonprofit health [services] SERVICE plan does not continue to satisfy the requirements of this subtitle, the Commissioner may disapprove the renewal of the certificate of authority of the nonprofit health service plan.

- (d) (6) The board shall have the following standing committees whose duties shall include:

  - (1) [a period of] 180 days after the date the coverage is denied; or
- (2) [until] THE DATE the carrier has [demonstrated,] DEMONSTRATED to the Commissioner's satisfaction that the carrier has sufficient policyholder surplus to underwrite additional coverage.
