SA25 DIVISION OF DEVELOPMENT FINANCE

(A) Rental Housing Programs. Provide funds for rental housing developments that serve low- and moderate-income households. The funds shall be administered in accordance with Article 83B, Title 2, Subtitle 5 and Sections 2-303, 2-305, and 2-803 (Statewide) ..... 7,409,000

(B) Partnership Rental Housing Program. Provide funds to be credited to the Partnership Rental Housing Fund to be administered in accordance with Article 83B, Sections 2-1101 through 2-1110 (Statewide)..... 6,000,000

(C) Homeownership Programs. Provide funds for below-market interest rate mortgages with minimum down payments to low- and moderate-income families. These funds shall be administered in accordance with Article 83B, Sections 2-601 through 2-605 and 2-608 through 2-614 (Statewide) ..... 2,989,000

(D) Shelter and Transitional Housing Facilities Grant Program. Provide grants to acquire, design, construct, renovate, and equip facilities for homeless individuals and families. The funds shall be administered in accordance with the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 05.05.09 (Statewide)..... 1,000,000
