AN ACT concerning

## Task Force on the HPV Vaccine Cervical Cancer Committee - HPV Vaccine Subcommittee

FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force on the HPV Vaccine; providing for the membership-and-staffing of the Task Force; providing that the members of the Task Force-may-not receive compensation but are entitled to a certain reimbursement; providing for the duties of the Task-Force; requiring the Task Force to report certain findings and recommendations to the Covernor and the General-Assembly on-or before a cortain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task-Force on the HPV Vaccine establishing the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine subcommittee in the Cervical Cancer Committee of the Maryland Comprehensive Cancer Control Plan; providing for the membership of the HPV vaccine subcommittee; providing for the duties of the HPV vaccine subcommittee; requiring the HPV vaccine subcommittee to submit a certain report to the Committee on or before a certain date each year; requiring a certain report of the Committee to include the findings and recommendations of the HPV vaccine subcommittee; and generally relating to the HPV vaccine subcommittee of the Cervical Cancer Committee.

<u>Chapter 283 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004</u> Section 1

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) There is a Task Force on the HPV Vaccine.
- (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- (1) one-member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (2) one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House:
