SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (a) There is a Task Force to Implement Holocaust, Genocide, Human Rights, and Tolerance Education in the State.
 - (b) (1) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- (i) [two-members ONE MEMBER] of the Senate of Maryland] THE-FOLLOWING-MEMBERS, appointed by the President of the Senate:
- 1. ONE MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND;
- 2. ONE FORMER MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND:
- (ii) [two-members <u>ONE MEMBER</u> of the House of Delegates] THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, appointed by the Speaker of the Houses:
- 1. ONE MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES;
- 2. ONE FORMER MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES;
- (iii) the Secretary of the Maryland Higher Education Commission, or the Secretary's designee;
- (iv) the Chancellor of the University System of Maryland, or the Chancellor's designee;
- $\mbox{(v)} \qquad \mbox{the State Superintendent of Schools, or the Superintendent's } \\ \mbox{designee; and} \\$
 - (vi) the following members, appointed by the Governor:
- 1. one professor of sociology at the University System of Maryland; and
- 2. $\underline{\text{five }}$ SEVEN members of the public who are residents of the State, with preference given to:
