

(b) Unless authorized to practice audiology under this title **OR UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN THIS ARTICLE**, a person may not use, with the intent to represent that the person practices audiology, [any of the following] words or terms, **INCLUDING**:

- (1) "Audiological";
- (2) "Audiologist";
- (3) "Audiology";
- (4) **"AURAL REHABILITATION"**;
- [(4)] (5) "Hearing clinic";
- [(5)] (6) "Hearing clinician"; ~~OR~~
- ~~[(6)]~~ (7) "Hearing ~~or aural~~ rehabilitation"; or]
- ~~(7)~~ (8) "Hearing specialist".

(c) While performing the duties of that employment, an individual employed by any agency of the federal government[, county public school system, State approved nonpublic school for handicapped children, chartered educational institution of this State, or the State Department of Education] may use any of the titles listed in subsection (b) of this section.

Unless authorized under this title to [provide hearing aid services] **PRACTICE HEARING AID DISPENSING OR UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN THIS ARTICLE**, a person may not represent to the public, by use of a title, including "licensed hearing aid dispenser", by description of services, methods, or procedures, or otherwise, that the person is authorized to [provide hearing aid services] **PRACTICE HEARING AID DISPENSING** in the State.
