

(F) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM AND THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL REPORT TO THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE STATUS OF, AND THE BENEFITS ACCRUED FROM, THE PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION MATCHING FUND PILOT PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of September 30, 2010, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

CHAPTER 638

(House Bill 1033)

AN ACT concerning

Health Insurance - Prescription Drugs and Devices - Copayment or Coinsurance

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations from imposing a copayment or coinsurance requirement for a covered prescription drug or device that exceeds the retail price of the prescription drug or device; making certain provisions of law applicable to health maintenance organizations; and generally relating to copayments and coinsurance for prescription drugs and devices.
