Know all men by these presents, that we John E. Applegarth, Richard H. Yubman, George H. McKinnis, Lemm L. Hene, George Wallace and Edward C. Johnson & Moses L. Hene of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland are held & firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Fifteen thousand Five hundred and nineteen dollars and thirty four Cents Current money of the United States to be paid to the said State or its Certain Attorney to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves and each of us four and each of our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this twenty sixth day of June in the year our Lord one thousand eight hundred & Fifty Five.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden John E. Applegarth appointed collector of the direct tax for Dorchester County shall well and faithfully execute the office of collector of the direct tax for said County and the several duties required of him by law and shall well and truly account for and pay to the Treasurer of Maryland the several sums of money which he shall receive for be answerable for by law, at such time as the law shall direct then the above obligation to be void, else to be and remain in full
