Seecombe, do hereby acknowledge, he granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said William Hearker his executors administrators and assigns the said negro Thomas Henry Jenkins a Slave to serve until the 15th day of December 1865 and no longer as by the will of Joshua Burrwoods of Worcester County will more fully appear To Have and to hold, the said negro Thomas Henry Jenkins above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be, for the aforesaid Term to the said William Hearker his Executors, administrators and assigns and I the said John W. Seecombe for my self, my Heirs, Executors and administrators the said negro Thomas Henry Jenkins unto the said William Hearker his Executor administrator and assigns against me the said John W. Seecombe my executor and administrator and against all and every other persons or persons whatsoever, Shall I will warrant & forever defend by these presents In witness we have hereunto set our hands & seals this 12th day of March Anno Domini 1853
