The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bondman James E. Douglass appointed collector of Worcester County shall well and faithfully execute his office and the several duties required of him, by law, and shall well and truly account for, and pay to the Commissioners for Worcester County, or their order the several sums of money which he shall receive or be accountable for by law at such time as the law shall direct, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.

Pennington of Worcester County in the State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid by William H. Jackson of the same County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the said William P. Pennington have
