(A) IN THIS SECTION "CANCER REPORT" MEANS A 1-TIME ABSTRACT OF THE MEDICAL RECORD OF A PATIENT DIAGNOSED OR TREATED FOR CANCER WHICH CONTAINS:

(1) REASONABLY OBTAINED PATIENT DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION, INCLUDING RISK FACTORS;

(2) RELEVANT INFORMATION ON THE:

(I) INITIAL DIAGNOSIS;

(II) INITIAL TREATMENT;

(III) EXTENT OF THE DISEASE BY THE END OF THE FIRST HOSPITALIZATION; AND

(IV) EXTENT OF THE DISEASE WITHIN 2 MONTHS OF DIAGNOSIS IF THE INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE TO THE REPORTING FACILITY AND THE REPORTING FACILITY HAS A TUMOR REGISTRY; AND

(3) FACILITY AND OTHER PROVIDER IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION.

~~(D)~~ (B) (1) EACH HOSPITAL WHICH HAS CARE OF A PATIENT WITH CANCER, AND EACH FREESTANDING LABORATORY OR THERAPEUTIC RADIOLOGICAL CENTER WHICH HAS CARE OF OR HAS DIAGNOSED CANCER FOR A NONHOSPITALIZED PATIENT, SHALL:

(I) 1. SUBMIT A CANCER REPORT TO THE SECRETARY, ON THE FORM THAT THE SECRETARY PROVIDES OR IN A COMPUTERIZED FILE, CONTAINING THE INFORMATION THAT THE SECRETARY REQUIRES; OR

2. MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE SECRETARY, OR AN AGENT OF THE SECRETARY, THE INFORMATION THE SECRETARY REQUIRES AT THE FACILITY THE INFORMATION NECESSARY TO COMPILE A CANCER REPORT; AND

(II) EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1993, SUBMIT, IN A MANNER REQUIRED BY THE SECRETARY, A COMPUTERIZED REPORT TO THE SECRETARY, OR AN AGENT OF THE SECRETARY, WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DIAGNOSIS OR TREATMENT. THE REPORT SHALL CONTAIN THE INFORMATION, AND SHALL BE IN THE FORMAT REQUIRED BY THE SECRETARY, OR AN AGENT OF THE SECRETARY A CANCER REPORT IN A COMPUTERIZED FILE ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE SECRETARY, OR AN AGENT OF THE SECRETARY, FOR ALL PATIENTS INITIALLY DIAGNOSED, TREATED, OR ADMITTED TO A FACILITY FOR CANCER DURING THAT CALENDAR QUARTER.
