SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Business Occupations and Professions

3–103.

(b) This title does not limit the right of:

(5) AN INTERIOR DESIGNER CERTIFIED UNDER TITLE 8.5 TO PROVIDE SERVICES RELATED TO THE LOCATION OR REMOVAL OF NONLOAD BEARING INTERIOR CONSTRUCTION WHICH IS NOT CONSTRUCTED AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL OR STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS.

TITLE 8.5. CERTIFIED INTERIOR DESIGNERS

SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS; GENERAL PROVISIONS

8.5–101.

(A) IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) “BOARD” MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF CERTIFIED INTERIOR DESIGNERS.

(C) “CERTIFICATE” MEANS A CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE BOARD TO USE THE TITLE “CERTIFIED INTERIOR DESIGNER”.

(D) “CERTIFIED INTERIOR DESIGNER” MEANS AN INTERIOR DESIGNER WHO IS CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD.

(E) “CERTIFIED INTERIOR DESIGN SERVICES” MEANS INTERIOR DESIGN SERVICES PROVIDED BY A CERTIFIED INTERIOR DESIGNER.

(F) “INTERIOR DESIGN SERVICES” MEANS RENDERING OR OFFERING TO RENDER SERVICES FOR A FEE OR OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, IN THE PREPARATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF
