Sections 35-138, 35-140, 35-141, and 35-145 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore County relate respectively, to the authority of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to exercise operating control over water extensions in the metropolitan district of Baltimore County established by Ch. 539, Acts of 1924, the establishment of rates charged by Baltimore City for water furnished to consumers in Baltimore County, the provision of water by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to the metropolitan district of Baltimore County at cost, and the approval by Baltimore City of plans for water line extensions by Baltimore County in the metropolitan district.

4-306. SAME — MUNICIPAL SERVICE IN TALBOT COUNTY.

(A) SCOPE.

THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN TALBOT COUNTY THAT SUPPLIES WATER TO AN AREA OUTSIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.

(B) CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY.

ON WRITTEN APPLICATION, THE COMMISSION MAY GRANT THE APPLICANT A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH A SERVICE AREA OUTSIDE OF ITS BOUNDARIES AND TO SUPPLY THAT SERVICE AREA WITH WATER.
