SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Personnel and Pensions

26-201.

(a) Except as provided in [subsections (b) and (c)] SUBSECTION (B) of this section, this subtitle applies only to:

(1) an employee of the Department of Natural Resources commissioned by the Secretary of Natural Resources as:

(i) a Natural Resources police officer; or

(ii) a law enforcement officer, other than a Natural Resources police officer;

(2) a law enforcement officer employed by the Maryland Investigative Services Unit;

(3) a member of the Maryland Transportation Authority Police Force who has the powers granted to a police officer under § 4-208 of the Transportation Article; [or]

(4) a deputy sheriff employed by the Baltimore City Sheriff's Department; OR

(5) A MEMBER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND POLICE FORCE WHO HAS THE POWERS GRANTED TO A POLICE OFFICER UNDER § 13-601 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

(b) This subtitle does not apply to:

(1) a Maryland Transportation Authority police officer who transferred from the Employees' Retirement System to the Employees' Pension System on or after December 1, 1996[.
