

(5) IN THE CASE OF AN EMERGENCY PESTICIDE APPLICATION IN AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER PESTICIDE APPLICATION, OR ON THE NEXT SCHOOL DAY, THE SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE TO EACH PARENT, GUARDIAN, AND STAFF MEMBER:

(I) THE COMMON NAME OF THE PESTICIDE;

(II) THE LOCATION OF THE APPLICATION;

(III) THE PLANNED DATE AND TIME OF APPLICATION;

(IV) THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY WARNING THAT PREGNANT WOMEN SHOULD REDUCE OR ELIMINATE EXPOSURE TO ALL PESTICIDES; AND

(V) THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE:

"THE OFFICE OF PESTICIDE PROGRAMS OF THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY HAS STATED:

"WHERE POSSIBLE, PERSONS WHO POTENTIALLY ARE MORE SENSITIVE, SUCH AS PREGNANT WOMEN AND INFANTS (LESS THAN TWO YEARS OLD), SHOULD AVOID ANY UNNECESSARY PESTICIDE EXPOSURE."; AND

(V) A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF POTENTIAL ADVERSE EFFECTS BASED UPON THE MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET OF THE PESTICIDES TO BE APPLIED.

~~(6) IN THE CASE OF EMERGENCY PESTICIDE APPLICATION BY SPACE SPRAYING, WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER THE APPLICATION OR ON THE NEXT SCHOOL DAY, THE SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE THE INFORMATION LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION BY UNIVERSAL NOTIFICATION.~~

~~(L) UNIVERSAL NOTIFICATION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE:~~

~~(1) DIRECTLY TRANSMITTED TO STAFF MEMBERS, AND~~

~~(2) IN THE CASE OF A PARENT OR GUARDIAN, EITHER DIRECTLY TRANSMITTED OR SENT HOME WITH EACH STUDENT.~~

(L) EACH SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL DEVELOP APPROPRIATE MEANS OF IN-SCHOOL NOTIFICATION BEFORE A BAIT STATION IS USED IN THE SCHOOL. THE MEANS MAY INCLUDE A SIGN POSTED ON THE DOOR OF THE ROOM IN WHICH THE BAIT STATION IS PLACED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the mandatory provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall apply to each county board of education starting in the 1999-2000 regular school year, but until the start of the 1999-2000 regular school year, county boards of education shall use their best efforts to comply with Section 1 of this Act.
