

TITLE 9. CARRIER COMPANIES.

SUBTITLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

9-101. COMMON CARRIERS — INTERCHANGE OF PASSENGERS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EACH COMMON CARRIER SHALL PROVIDE REASONABLE, PROPER, AND EQUAL FACILITIES FOR THE PROMPT INTERCHANGE AND TRANSFER OF PASSENGERS BETWEEN ITS LINES AND THE LINES OF EVERY OTHER COMMON CARRIER.

(B) DISCRIMINATION AMONG COMMON CARRIERS PROHIBITED.

A COMMON CARRIER MAY NOT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST OTHER COMMON CARRIERS IN TRANSFERRING, RECEIVING, OR FORWARDING PASSENGERS TO OR FROM OTHER COMMON CARRIERS.

(C) USE OF TRACK OR TERMINAL FACILITIES NOT MANDATORY.

A COMMON CARRIER IS NOT REQUIRED TO ALLOW ANY OTHER COMMON CARRIER TO USE ITS TRACKS OR TERMINAL FACILITIES.

9-102. SAME — COMPENSATION FOR TRANSPORTATION OVER SAME LINE.

UNLESS THE COMMISSION ORDERS OTHERWISE, A COMMON CARRIER MAY NOT CHARGE OR RECEIVE AN EQUAL OR GREATER COMPENSATION IN THE AGGREGATE TO TRANSPORT PASSENGERS UNDER SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR CIRCUMSTANCES FOR A SHORTER DISTANCE THAN FOR A LONGER DISTANCE OVER THE SAME LINE AND IN THE SAME DIRECTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 78, § 30.

The former reference to transportation of "a like kind of property" is deleted as obsolete. The Public Service Commission no longer regulates common carriage of freight.

The former phrase "which includes the shorter", which modified the phrase "the same direction", is deleted as implicit.

9-103. SAME — TARIFF SCHEDULES.

(A) IN GENERAL.
