(1) ALL REVENUE RECEIVED THROUGH THE IMPOSITION AND COLLECTION OF THE ASSESSMENT FEE UNDER SUBTITLE 5 OF THIS TITLE; AND

(2) ALL REVENUE RECEIVED THROUGH THE IMPOSITION AND COLLECTION OF THE FEES SET FORTH IN § 2-112 OF THIS TITLE;
