Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 452.

This bill allows tax exempt organizations to receive Work, Not Welfare and Qualifying Employees with Disabilities tax credits and to apply the credits to the income tax the organization is required to withhold from wages of employees. If the full amount of the credit is not used in the year in which the credit is claimed, it can be carried forward for five years.

House Bill 1155, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 21, 1998, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 452.

**Senate Bill No. 452**

AN ACT concerning

**Work, Not Welfare, and Qualifying Employees with Disabilities Tax Credits -  
Tax Exempt Organizations - Withholding Taxes**

FOR the purpose of allowing certain tax exempt organizations to apply certain tax credits against the payment to the Comptroller of certain taxes required to be withheld from the wages of employees and required to be paid to the Comptroller; altering certain provisions relating to the applicability of certain tax credits; making certain provisions of this Act contingent on the taking effect of certain other legislation; and generally relating to the application of certain tax credits for certain tax exempt organizations against certain payments.
