(b) A health care provider shall disclose a medical record without the authorization of a person in interest:

(6) (ii) [A] IN ACCORDANCE WITH A stipulation by a patient or person in interest; or

(iii) [A] IN ACCORDANCE WITH A discovery request permitted by law to be made to a court, an administrative tribunal, or a party to a civil court, administrative, or health claims arbitration proceeding;

(h) (1) A health care provider shall disclose a medical record without the authorization of a person in interest:

(ii) To the State designated protection and advocacy system for mentally ill individuals under the [Federal] FEDERAL Protection and Advocacy for Mentally Ill Individuals Act of 1986, as amended, if:

1. The State designated protection and advocacy system has received a complaint regarding the recipient or the director of the system has certified in writing to the chief administrative officer of the health care provider that there is probable cause to believe that the recipient has been subject to abuse or neglect;
