(c) Before a certificate of qualification expires, the holder of the certificate of qualification may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the holder:

(1) otherwise is entitled to a certificate of qualification;

(2) files with the Commissioner a renewal application on the form that the Commissioner provides;

(3) completes the continuing education requirements established under § 10-116 of this subtitle by [June 15 immediately prior to the expiration of the certificate of qualification] THE JUNE 30 ON WHICH THE CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION EXPIRES; and

(4) pays to the Commissioner the renewal fee required by § 2-112 of this article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 41

(House Bill 90)

AN ACT concerning

Office on Aging - Senior Citizen Activities Centers Capital Improvement Grants Program - Grant Amounts

FOR the purpose of clarifying the circumstances under which a grantee of the Senior Citizen Activities Centers Capital Improvement Grants Program may qualify for subsequent grants; specifying that the sum of the prior grant and any subsequent grants may not exceed maximum funding allowed under the Program; and generally relating to the Senior Citizen Activities Centers Capital Improvement Grants Program.
