

zoning or subdivision, each district council may provide by ordinance regulations for the protection, preservation and enhancement of sites, structures with their appurtenances and environmental settings, or districts of historical, archeological, architectural or cultural value designated on the adopted and approved general plan. The enactment and application of these regulations shall be reasonable and appropriate to the purpose of this section and are limited to the protection, preservation and enhancement of the exterior of the sites, structures or districts, and, if such action constitutes a taking of private property, provision shall be made for just compensation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.

CHAPTER 367

(Senate Bill 96)

AN ACT concerning

Education – Truancy Rates – Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support Programs and Behavior Modification Programs

FOR the purpose of requiring a county board of education to require certain schools with certain truancy rates to implement a positive behavioral interventions and support program or certain behavior modification programs in collaboration with the State Department of Education under certain circumstances; requiring certain schools to expand certain programs under certain circumstances; clarifying language; and generally relating to the requirement that certain schools implement certain programs relating to truancy rates.
