AN ACT concerning

Revitalization Tax Credit

FOR the purpose of authorizing a taxpayer to receive a revitalization tax credit even if the
taxpayer applies for the tax credit more than 120 days after the assessment of
qualified improvement; limiting the duration of a tax credit applied for more than
120 days after the assessment of qualified improvement; providing for the start
date of a tax credit applied for more than 120 days after the assessment of
qualified improvements; and generally relating to the revitalization tax credit.
