Mr. Thomas moved to strike out the word "the" to insert "any future" before the word "legislature;" in the 6th section. Determined in the negative.

Mr. Lee moved the following as an additional section:

Sec. 7. And be it enacted, That the sum of four dollars per day be allowed to each and every of the said directors, as a compensation for the time they are actually occupied in the performance of the several duties enjoined upon them by this act; a certificate whereof shall be signed by the president of said board.

Mr. Eccleston moved to add the following: "which shall be in lieu of all other compensation or allowance." Determined in the negative.

The question was then put on the amendment proposed by Mr. Lee. Determined in the negative.

Mr. Williams moved to insert after the word "works" in the 8th section, the following: "provided always, that the said warrant shall have been first submitted to and approved by the governor and council." Determined in the negative.

Mr. Merrick moved to fill up the blank with \$10,000? Determined in the negative.

Mr. Farquhar moved \$9,000? Determined in the negative.

Mr. M'Culloh moved \$8,000? Determined in the negative.

Mr. Estep moved \$7,000? Determined in the negative.

Mr. Kennedy moved \$6000.
