

The speaker laid before the house a remonstrance from sundry inhabitants of Kent county, relative to the landing called The Ship Yard; referred to the committee on that subject.

Mr. Teackle reports a bill, entitled, An act supplementary to an act, entitled, An act to provide for the prompt settlement of public accounts, and the collection of the public revenue.

The bill establishing the times of paying the salaries of civil officers, and the pensions of revolutionary officers and soldiers, and of their widows, was read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

On the second reading of the bill to repeal certain acts of assembly relative to amerciements, and to lay a tax on plaintiffs who may institute actions at law in the several county courts of this state,
