

On motion by Mr. Sappington, the question was put, That the following be added to the bill.

“And be it enacted, That a copy of any judgment rendered by magistrates, for a sum exceeding the sum of fifty dollars, shall be transmitted by the magistrate who gives it, to the clerk of the county wherein the judgment may be given, who shall record the same, and when recorded, said judgment shall be a lien upon any real property that may be holden by the person against whom the judgment is awarded.”
