The Condition of the above Recognizance is such that if the above Bounden Mary Milbourn do well and truly Learn the above said Elizabeth Cook during her servitude to Read Knitt sew and Spin and other housewifery, and at the Expiration of her servitude to give her anew suit of Cloathes, and also find and provide for her said servant sufficient meat drink washing Lodging and Bathing unto for such a servant to have and wear during her servitude aforesaid then the above Obligation to void otherwise to remain in full force and vertue in Law
