Inconsideration of which I provide the said Thomas William un-

his servitude as, and likewise to find and provide for his said Servant during the term as usual  
Drink washing Lodging and Cloathing Meats for such an apprentice to have and wear &c

Wherefore it is ordered by the Court that the said Thomas William give Recognizance  
in twenty pounds Sterling for to comply with the covenants as

Thereupon the said Thomas William acknowledged himselfe to owe unto the  
said William Gusey Twenty pounds Good and Lawfull money of Great Brittain of his goods  
and Chattels Lands or Tenements to be made and Levied for the Use of the said William Gusey  
his heirs and assigns if default be made in the Condition hereunder Written

The Condition of this Recognizance is such that if the above bounden Thomas William  
do and shall well and truly perform fullfile and keep all and singular the Covenants articles and  
agreements abovesaid on his part to be performed fullfiled and kept then the above Recognizance  
to be void otherwise &c

is at the prayer of M<sup>r</sup> George Dashiell discharged from the paying of taxes &c

Tom negro of M<sup>r</sup> George Dashiell being blind and not able to work whereby to  
maintain himselfe is discharged from paying of taxes for the future &c

Gonah negro of George Down being lame is discharged from paying of taxes  
for the future

Sam<sup>r</sup> a disabled boy living with Sambo Lane is discharged from paying of taxes  
for the future &c

Henry Fitzwaters of Somerset County Inholder being his Servant man in to Court  
named Morris Chheane who had run away and absented himselfe out of his Masters Service  
forty five days. Whereupon the said Henry Fitzwaters prays the Court that the said Morris  
may be adjudged to serve him for the run away time as according to act of assembly also the said  
Henry prays the Court that the said Morris may be adjudged to serve him according to Law for four  
pounds eight shillings which he paid for pursuing, apprehending and Imprisonment of  
when run away as aforesaid. Whereupon it is considered by the Court that the said Morris Chheane  
serve his said Master eight days for every day that he was run away as aforesaid which amount  
in the whole to three hundred and sixty days, Likewise the said Morris adjudged to serve his  
said
