Mr Kerr from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, made a favorable report upon the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to make valid a deed from Benjamin Sanders and wife, to Wm. Lamb, of Kent county,

Which was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Citizens Bank of Baltimore, passed at December session 1835, ch. 314,

Also, the bill, entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Farmers' and Planters' Bank of Baltimore, passed at December session 1835, ch. 315; severally endorsed, "will pass," ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill, entitled, an act to make valid the instrument of writing therein mentioned, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment,"

Which amendment was read the first, and by special order the second time, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to regulate the manner of taking testimony in cases in equity, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments;"

Which amendments were severally read the first, and by special order, the second time.

Mr. Alexander moved that said amendments be rejected; Resolved in the affirmative.

The clerk of the Senate also delivered a communication from the Treasurer of the Western Shore, made in obedience to resolution No. 77, of December session 1827, endorsed, "referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates;"

Which was read, and with the enclosure, referred to the committee on ways and means;

Also, a communication from the Executive, endorsed, "referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates," and is as follows:
