

The house took up for consideration the amendment proposed by the Senate to the resolution granting the use of the Library to certain persons therein named;

The said amendment was then read the second time, assented to, and the resolution ordered to be engrossed.

Mr. Brengle reported a bill entitled, an act to prevent private bankers from issuing notes in the shape of bank notes;

Which was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Matthias reported a bill entitled, an act for the establishment of the orphans' court of Carroll county;

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and passed.

On motion of Mr. Buchanan,

The preamble and order submitted by him on the 2d inst. in relation to requiring the chancellor and the several chief judges of the different judicial districts, and the chief justices of the several orphan's courts, to report whether they have examined into the manner in which public records have been kept, and the papers recorded as required by law, &c, was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Buchanan,

Said order was amended by adding at the end of the first order, the following:

"And also to examine the bonds of said officers, and report whether said bonds have been regularly given, according to the act of Assembly;

On motion of Mr. Buchanan,

The second order was amended, by striking out the word "written."

The said preamble and orders were then read the second time as amended, and adopted.

On motion of Mr. Harris,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by him, entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for the preservation of wild fowl in the Potomac river and its tributary streams, passed December session 1832, ch. 134.

On motion of Mr. Harris, said bill was amended, by striking out in the 1st section after the enacting clause to the end of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

That from and after 1st of October next, in all cases of a violation of the provisions of the act, to which this is a supplement, it shall be the duty of such justice of the peace of this State, as shall be applied to for that purpose
