Mr. Simmons, from the select committee, made an unfavourable report upon the memorial of Richard Brown, of Anne Arundel county, praying to be permitted to close up a road therein mentioned;

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, and concurred in.

Mr. Alexander, chairman of the committee on ways and means, delivered the following reports:

The committee of ways and means to whom was referred the petition of Charles J. Kilgour and other citizens of Montgomery county, praying an act to incorporate a Bank to be located at Rockville in said county, to be called the Maryland Bank of Potomac, beg leave to report that they are not convinced of the necessity for the creation of the proposed Bank, and therefore pray to be discharged from the further consideration of said petition.

The committee of ways and means, to whom was referred the petition of Jacob Snively and others of Washington county, praying for a change in the license law of this State as to the time of issuing license to keepers of ordinaries and merchants, and also the petition of sundry citizens of Carroll and Baltimore counties, praying an amendment to the license laws of this State, so as to encourage the keeping of houses of entertainment without vending ardent spirits, have had the same under consideration and beg leave to report.

That at this late period of the session, it is inexpedient to propose any alteration in the general license laws of the State, and therefore pray to be discharged from the further consideration of said petitions.

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Brengle, reported a bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, to regulate the manner of obtaining and altering public roads in this State, passed January 6th 1819;

Mr. Boyd, reported a bill, entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of the town of Havre de Grace, to convey to the Baltimore and Port Deposit Rail-road company, a part of St. Clair street in said town;

Mr. Palmer, reported a bill, entitled, an act for the benefit of the Sheriff of Queen Anne's county;

Mr. Matthias, reported a bill, entitled, an act to provide for the building of a court house, clerks office, registers office, goal and poors house in Carroll county;—and,
