And, the bill entitled, an act to prohibit the owners of vessels and others from navigating the same by and under the sole command of negroes or mulattoes;

Mr. Ghiselin presented a petition of Samuel Barrow and others, citizens of Prince George's county, praying that Mary A. Garner may be placed on the pension roll of said county;

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment.

Mr. Buchanan presented a communication from William Lamar, esq., an officer of the revolution, in relation to his revolutionary services;

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.
