

The bill, entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Anne Arundel county, to levy a sum of money for the payment of a clerk to the commissioners of Primary schools;—Also,

The bill, entitled a supplement to an act for the relief and support of the poor and indigent persons in Worcester county, passed at December session 1835 chapter 219;

Also, the bill, entitled, a further additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act for the founding an academy at Hagerstown in Washington county;—Also,

The bill, entitled, an act to build a bridge over the Great Gunpowder Falls, where the county road leading from Middletown, to the falls road crosses said falls in Baltimore county;—And,

The bill, entitled, an act to build a bridge in Baltimore county, over the White marsh run, at or near the head of Birds river;

Were sent to the senate.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act for the relief of James B Wagner, an insolvent debtor;—Also,

The bill, entitled, an act for the relief of Edward Hines, late of Kent county;—And,

The bill, entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs and devisees of Docter Elisha J. Hall, late of Baltimore county, deceased;

Were returned to the senate.

Mr. Buchanan presented a petition of Sundry citizens of Allegany county, praying that a certain woman of color named Flora Freeman, may be permitted to come into this State;

Which was read and referred to the committee on coloured population;

Mr. Shower presented two memorials of sundry citizens of the city of Baltimore, counter to the memorial praying that an Inspector General of domestic distilled spirits may be appointed;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on inspections.

Mr. Boyd, chairman of the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, made unfavorable reports upon the petitions of Elisha Brown and Basil Owings, praying compensation for the support of Thomas Jones, a soldier of the revolution;

And, the petition of Mary Wells, praying for a pension;
